WORKPLACE HEALTH AND SAFETY, MAINTENANCE AND IMPROVEMENTS:

RECENT ACTIVITIES - annual servicing of ACs in church/chapel, presbytery, parish office and OSHC building.

<u>CURRENT TASKS NEEDING TO BE DONE</u> – Chapel split system AC requires a new outdoor thermistor cluster due to the outdoor heat exchanger thermistor being chewed by vermin, replace rotted out timber planking in OSHC verandah (scheduled Saturday 14 Sept), water blast pathways around Parish Office (scheduled 19 August), complete the painting of OSHC verandah wall, removal of mould and sanding/painting of presbytery window sills doors and door frames (scheduled for 2024), repair/replace damaged fence panel in church carpark (on hold), painting of presbytery gutters and eaves (on hold), plaster repairs to ceilings in presbytery.

<u>POSSIBLE FUTURE PROJECTS DEPENDING ON AVAILABILITY OF FUNDING</u> – replace rotted-out fence posts (presbytery yard fence along side school oval).
